SUBPART P EXCAVATION COMPETENT PERSON TRAINING

OSHA 1926 Subpart P Excavation standards are a performance standard. Companies are given four options to decide how they will provide a safe work place. The most popular option is one that requires a contractor to have a competent person on the jobsite to make the decisions pertaining to the job for the contractor. This person must be trained in both the standards and in hazard recognition. He or she must also be given full authorization to remove your employees from danger and take prompt corrective action. This course has been developed to start you and your employees toward the proper understanding of the requirements set down by this law.

This course will discuss the competent person's authority over jobsite safety, hazard recognition, compliance and the company's participation, including the scope, definition, application and interpretation of the IOSHA standards and how they affect your work procedures and recordkeeping. Learn how to prepare and react to an onsite inspection. Get an explanation and discussion of soils, benching, sloping, shoring, protective systems and OSHA's interpretations of them. A written test and review will be included.
